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The European Education Area by 2025

- High-quality education, irrespective of socio-economic background
- No barriers to learning and training abroad
- Automatic mutual recognition
- Speaking two languages, in addition to one's mother tongue, is the norm
- Strong sense of a European student identity

Digitalising and standardising student mobility administration processes



Rolling out the “European Student Card” and enabling online authentication of students’ identity across Europe

Timescales

Use of the data transfer standards will become gradually mandatory in the next Erasmus programme

- **2021:** Inter-institutional agreements and Online learning agreements
- **2022:** Nominations
- **2023:** Transcripts of records

Timescale depends on systems being fully tested by higher education institutions and confirmed fit for purpose!

By 2025: European Student Card available to all students in Europe

To achieve this, European Student Card Digital Officers are working with the Commission to assist with communication, training and planning.

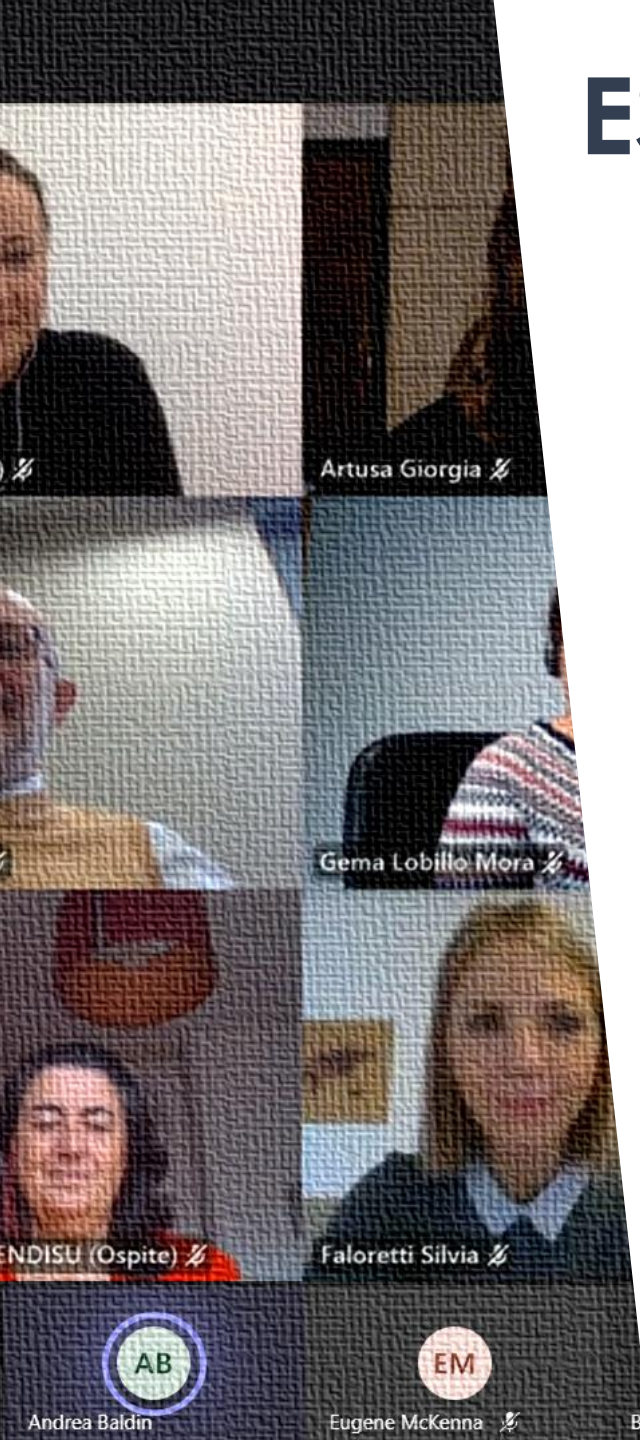

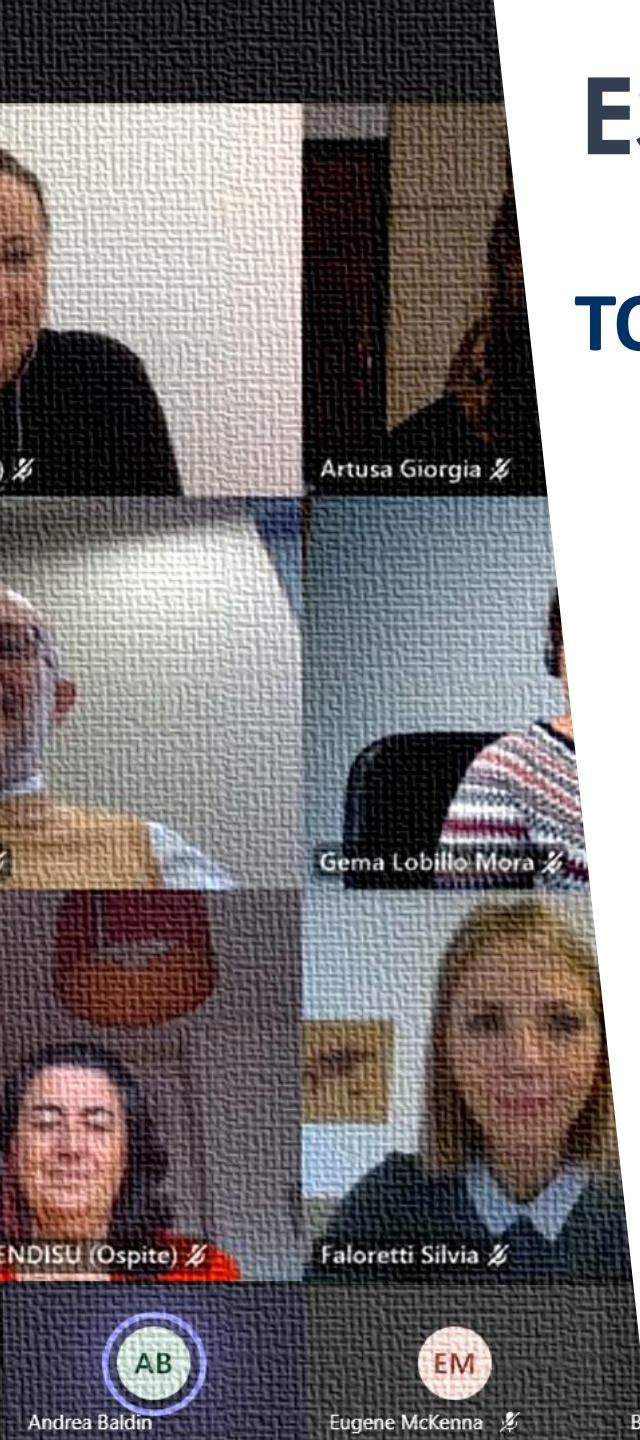


TO PROMOTE

 - The importance of a physical ID

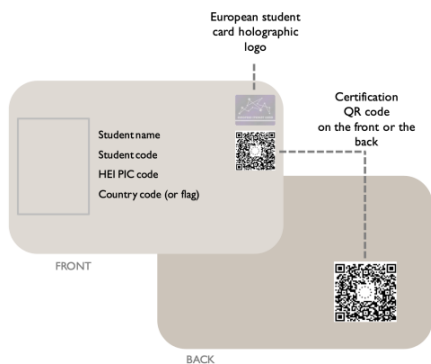
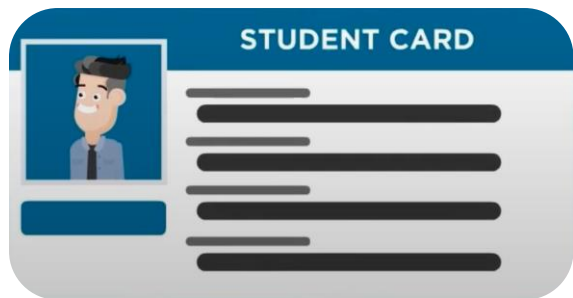
This is the reason behind the ESC-tension Multidimensional Matrix connecting cards with services.

For example, the data is as followed for a student enrolled at the university Paris 13:

- FR for France;
- No region code;
- 99948994 is the PIC code of the university;
- The national student identifier (NSI, INE in French) contains ten digits and one letter, for example 1234567890G.

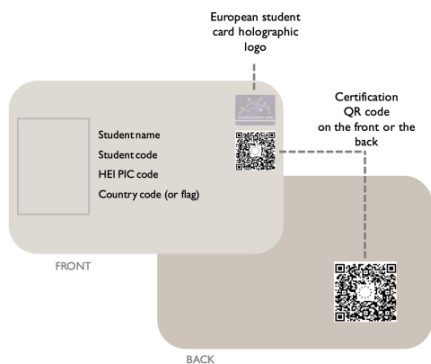
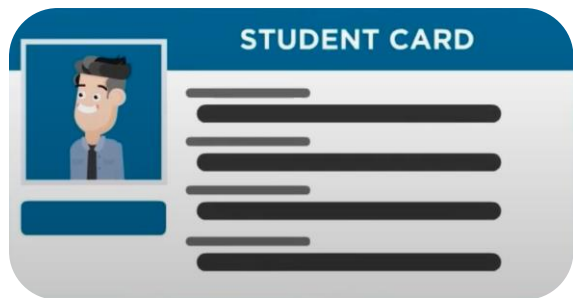

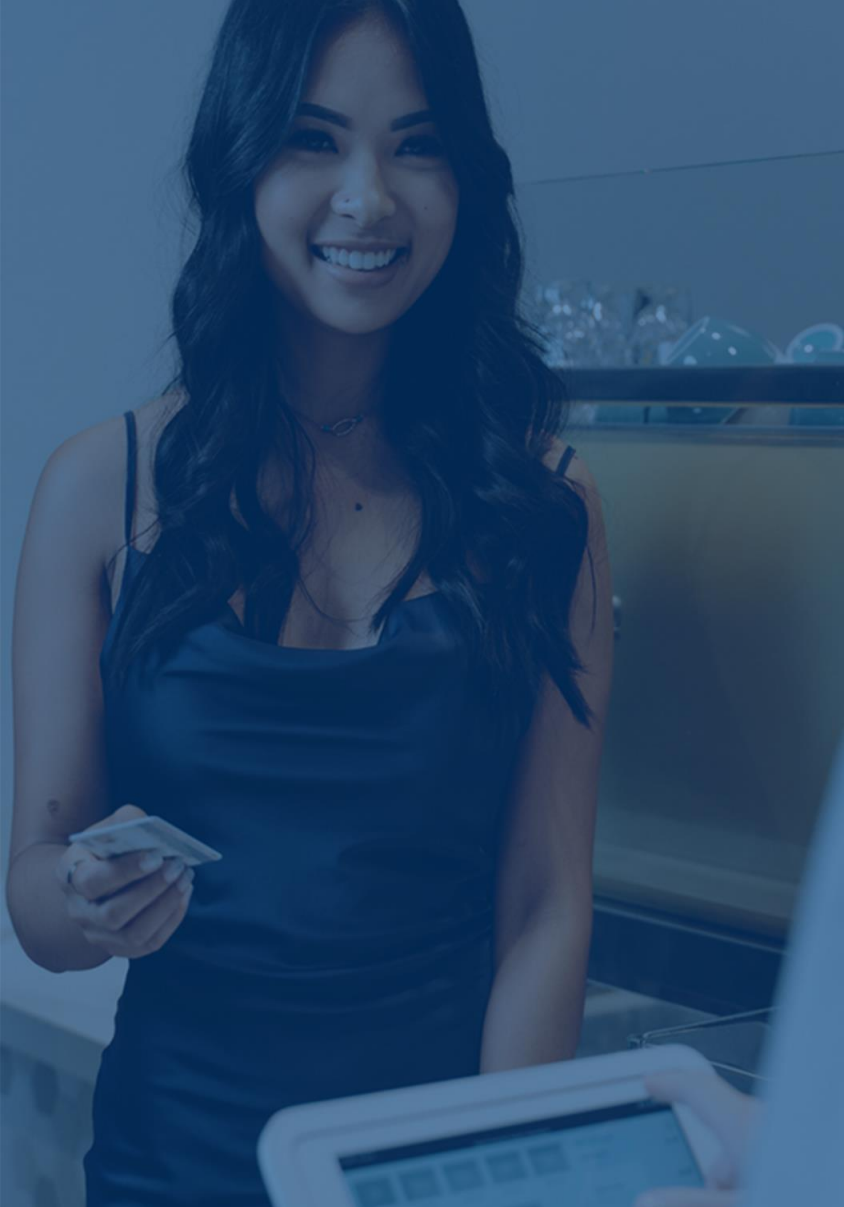
EU Student Card Extension and Adoption
